RECRUITMENT PROGRESS

- **Total recruitment: 36 participants**
- Recruitment target: 112 participants
- Recruitment is suspended until we receive further guidance from the relevant authorities.

Please keep a screening log of potentially eligible participants for recruitment later or a list of ICH patients if you have staff capacity issues.

- We have been impressed by your huge effort to obtain BP data for the 3 month follow up visits.

FOLLOW UP VISITS

3 month follow up visit – to be done remotely if your site does not allow in person visits yet

- 24 hr ABPM should still happen as scheduled. Please contact the Oxford team by email for guidance in advance of the visit.
- For cognitive assessment, use 22 point telephone MoCA instead.

12 month follow up visit – all parts of the visit are postponed until MRI scanners are available at your site.

- The visit should happen as close as possible to the scheduled visit. once restrictions are lifted.
- Please delay eCRF completion until then.
